CASH RENTAL ASSISTANCE


Eviction Defense Collaborative (EDC) will provide SFUSD employees* with cash rental assistance to maintain a current residency if back rent is owed.

 EDC may be able to provide some cash assistance for security deposits payable to a new landlord.



LEGAL REPRESENTATION

Experienced representation makes tenants facing eviction far more likely to prevail and maintain current housing.

 EDC and Justice & Diversity Center staff or volunteer attorneys prioritize SFUSD staff* for legal representation in eviction proceedings. Experienced litigators will represent SFUSD employees using all available legal tools.
